CDC LANDMARK VB

CDC Landmark VB is a very high yielding semi-dwarf spring wheat with a **semi solid stem** for high pressure sawfly areas. CDC Landmark VB is rated I to Fusarium head blight and is also tolerant to the orange wheat blossom midge. CDC Landmark VB is well-adapted to the wheat growing regions across North Dakota, Eastern Montana, and Northwest Minnesota. Certified seed of CDC Landmark VB will be sold as a varietal blend made up of 90% CDC Landmark and 10% AAC Viewfield. AAC Viewfield provides a refuge area for non-virulent midge to survive at low levels, thereby extending the useful life of the SM1 midge tolerant gene. **CDC Landmark VB will be marketed as certified seed only (CSO).** This method will maintain the midge resistance going into the future.
